Founded in 1931, the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra (SSO) is a professional orchestra based in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan.

With a mission of performing diverse repertoire spanning classical masterworks, contemporary compositions and innovative cross-genre collaborations, SSO aims to engage audiences of all ages and backgrounds through dynamic, immersive concert experiences.

Along with standard symphonic repertoire, SSO champions the work of diverse composers and artists, cultivating an environment of artistic excellence, collaboration, and creative exploration.

As one of the most innovative arts organization in North America, SSO has been at the forefront of embracing technological advancements, providing full seasons of live-streamed performances via its own streaming app, ConcertStream.TV since 2020/21.

The orchestra regularly performs at the 2000-seat TCU Place Concert Hall, Knox United Church, and various venues throughout the city.
